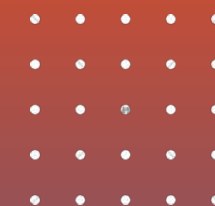

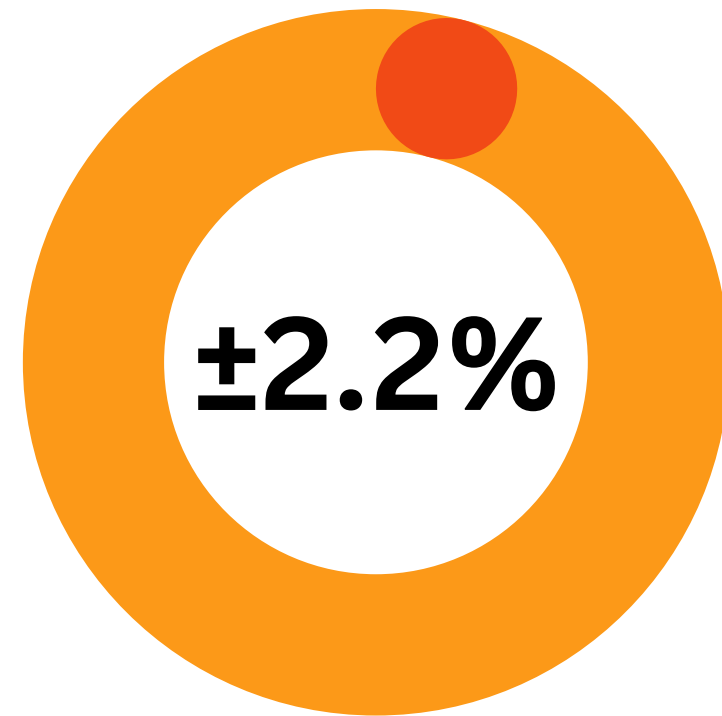

Margin of Error



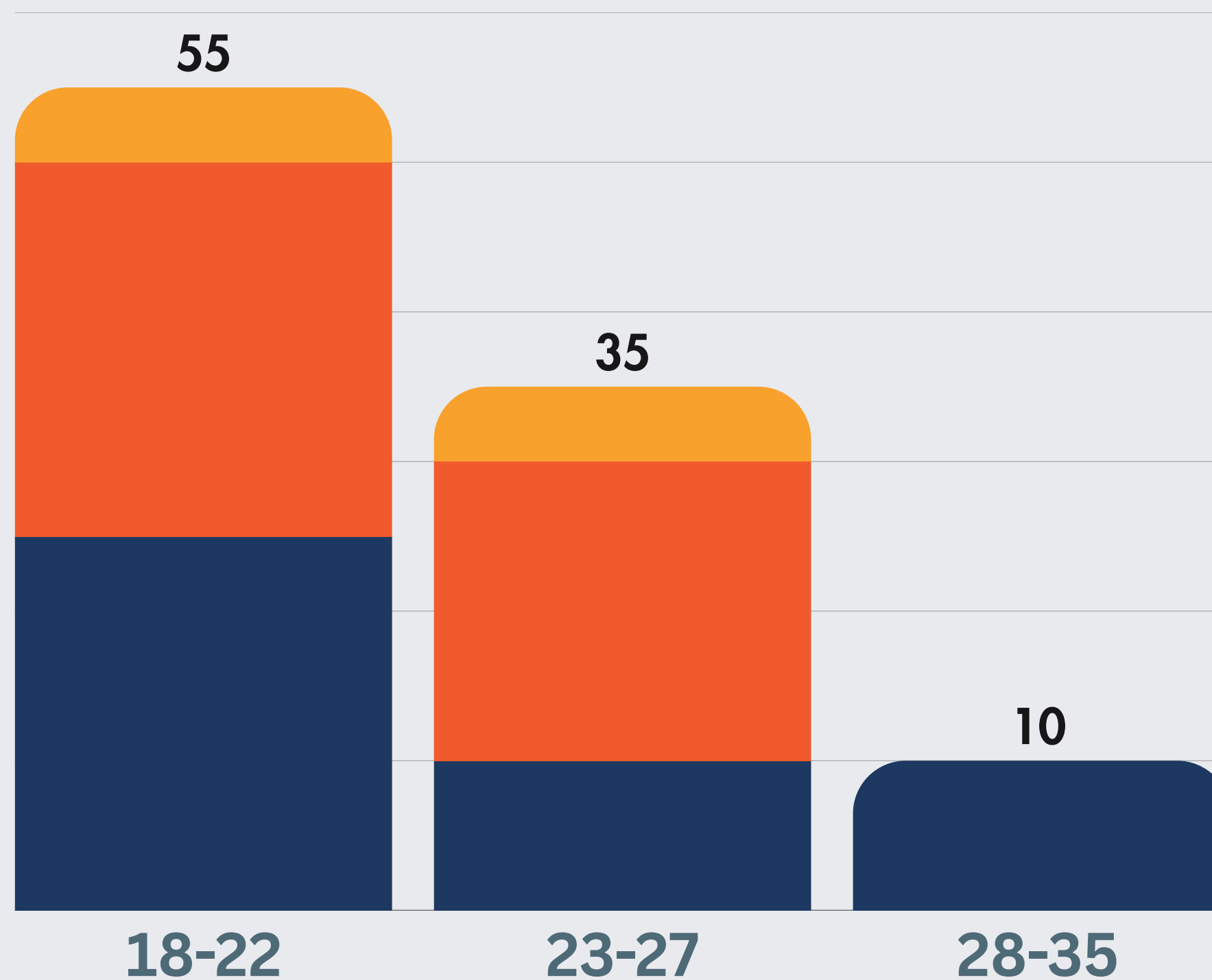

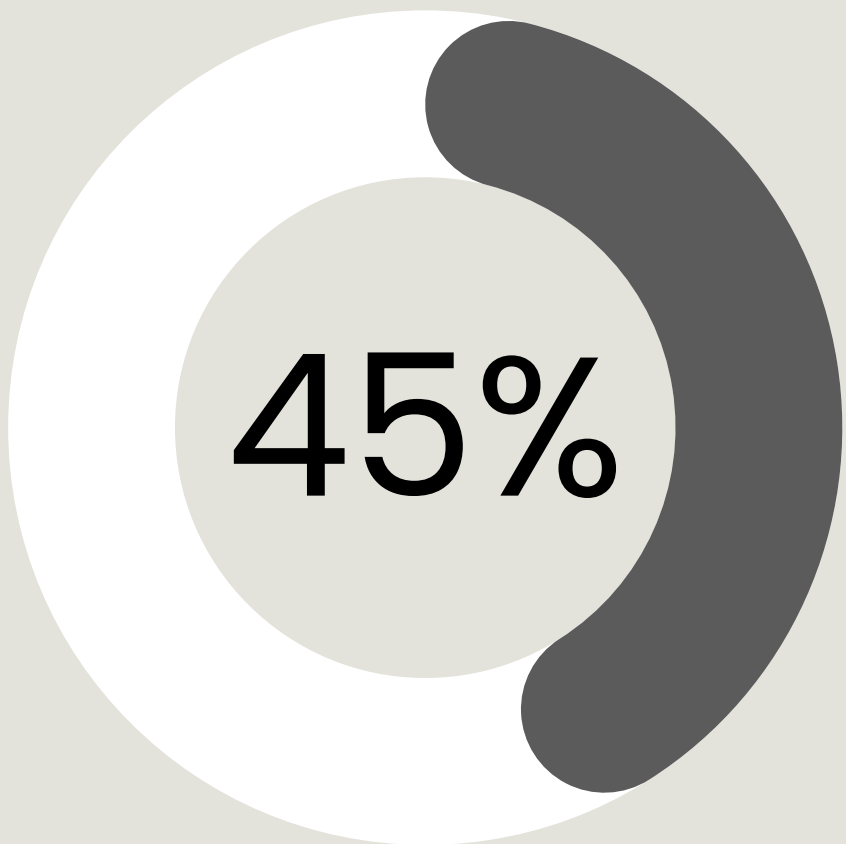

Sample Distribution



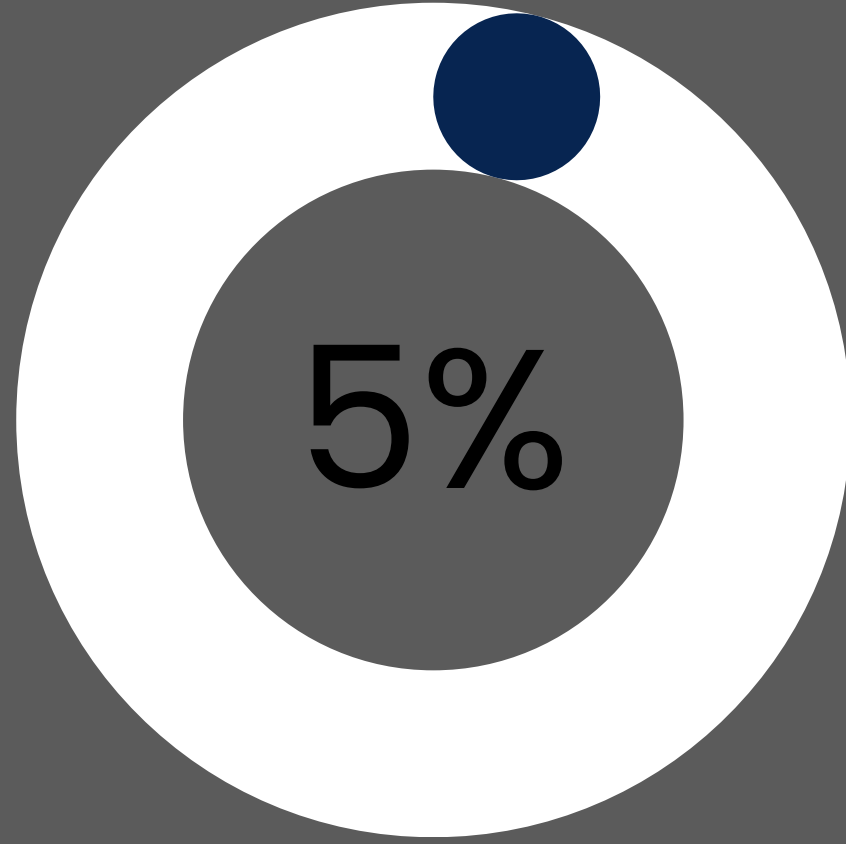

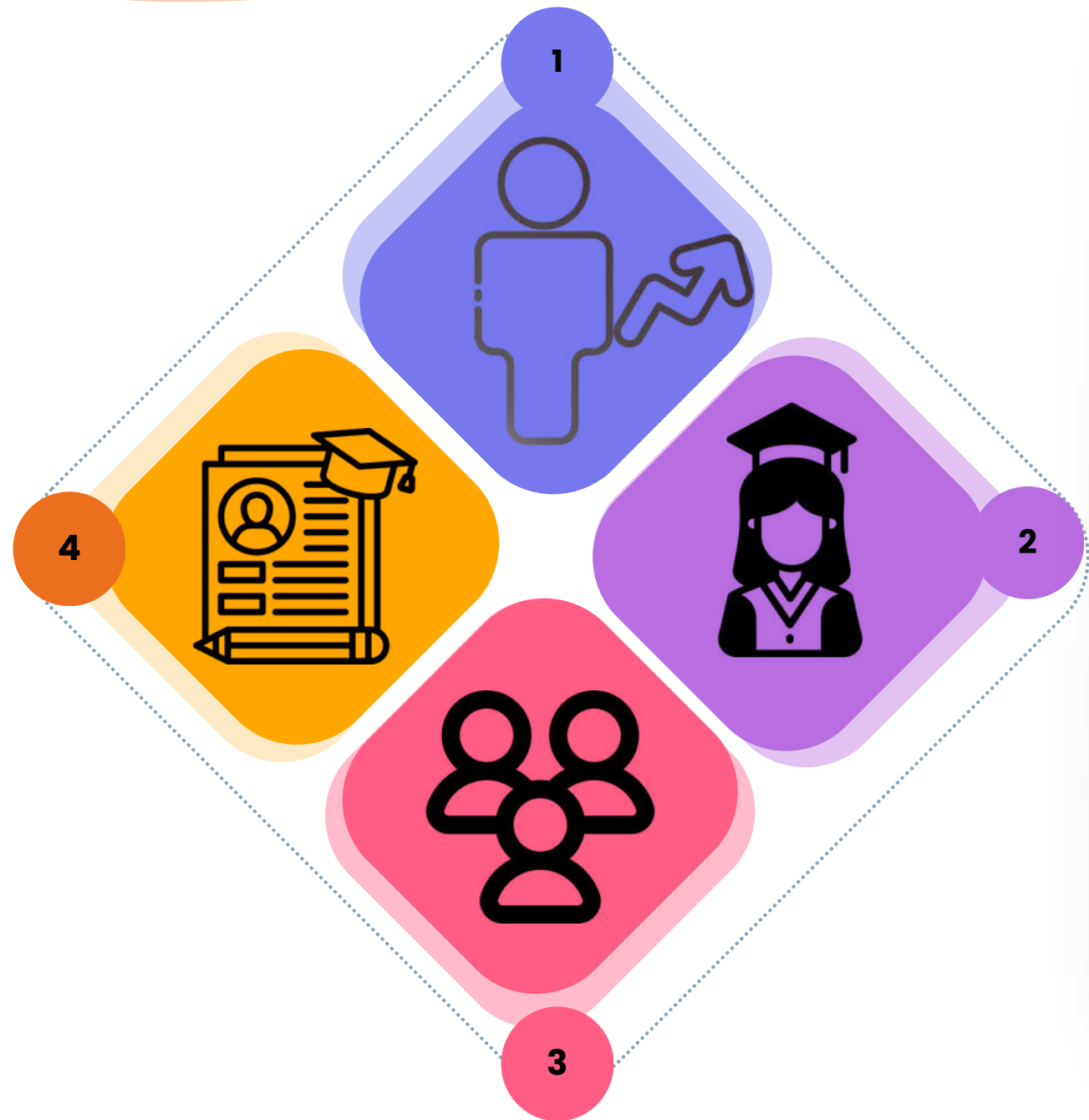

Key Challenges Facing TVETs in Kenya



Inadequate Funding



Limited financial resources affect infrastructure, equipment, and staff development.

Outdated Training Equipment



Many institutions rely on obsolete tools that do not match current industry standards.

Infighting within the School Administration



Internal conflicts slow down progress and disrupt institutional focus.

Mismanagement of Funds and Public Resources



Poor financial accountability affects project implementation and service delivery.

Community Outreach and Marketing



A lack of qualified instructors limits the delivery of high-quality, competency-based training.

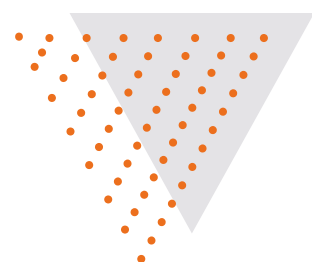


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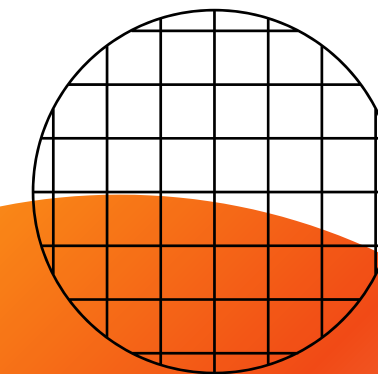
